Description: The project will reconstruct Twitchell roadway at the Governor Hugh J. Gallen State Office Park campus in Concord, NH. The work includes reclaiming and paving the existing pavement roadway and associated parking areas. Drainage improvements include installing new structures, piping and infiltration trenches. The parking lot will be finished with pavement striping, new parking signs and site lighting.

The project will require to have the pavement binder course completed by November 15, 2024. See specification section 01100 Summary for more project details.

The Project will include the Discipline(s) of: Site Construction, Concrete and Electrical.

Plans and specifications will be available at the Department of Transportation on April 18, 2024.

In order to be authorized to bid, the Department’s Request for Proposal (RFP) form must be submitted to the Contract Office of the Department of Transportation. Once the RFP has been approved, the Contractor is authorized to bid. At this time, the password card will be issued allowing the Contractor access to the online bidding documents, including Plans and Specifications. Hard copies of the Bidding Documents can be obtained from the NH Department of Transportation, Finance & Contracts Office, Room 130, Concord, NH 03302-0483 upon deposit of Forty-five Dollars, (\$45.00) NON-REFUNDABLE. AN ADDITIONAL \$10.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR SHIPPING. Checks are to be made payable to “Treasurer, State of New Hampshire”. Project completion date is June 13, 2025, with an intermediate completion date of November 15, 2024 for the installation of the pavement binder course.

Proposals must be submitted electronically via <https://nhdot.exevision.com/icx/Index.aspx> and received by the Department of Transportation as specified above no later than the date and time mentioned above, at which time they will be publicly opened and the results immediately posted on the Department’s website. A bid bond shall be submitted electronically at the time of bid in the amount listed below, payable to, “Treasurer, State of New Hampshire,” as security for the execution of the contract.

All individuals, firms, partnerships or corporations intending to bid, before obtaining plans and specifications, must file with the Department of Transportation on forms prepared for that purpose at least ten (10) days prior to opening of bids, a statement showing their qualifications. No valid bidding proposal will be issued to a prospective bidder who is not qualified.


Companies, corporations or trade names, except sole proprietorships must be registered with the Secretary of State (Corporate Division, Telephone No. 603/271-3244) in order to do business with the State of New Hampshire.

Bidders are advised that final bid award, as approved by Governor and Executive Council, and issuance of a notification to proceed with the work, can occur up to 60 days or more after the bid opening date.

Per section 00204.18.2, Low Bidder has **10 days** after notice of award to submit signed Contract, Certificate of Insurance, and Disadvantage Business Enterprise forms, if required.

Bidders must submit a 5% bid security at Bid and must furnish a 100% payment and performance security prior to execution of contract.

The right is reserved to waive any informalities in or to reject any or all proposals.
