

Limited Access Highways

The safety of volunteers is a primary concern of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation. For that reason, Sponsor-A-Highway involves the use of “Maintenance Providers” to accomplish litter removal because the safety of our volunteers cannot be reasonably maintained on these high-speed highways. Limited Access Highways requiring the use of maintenance providers include:



- All Interstate highways including I-95, I-93, I-89, I-293 and I-393.
- The Turnpike System including Blue Star, Central (F.E. Everette Turnpike), and the Spaulding Turnpikes.
- NH Route 101 from Bedford to I-95

Maintenance Providers are private companies that perform litter removal activities under strict safety guidelines for a sponsoring group.

Individuals or groups wishing to participate in the program can submit an application to the Sponsor-A-Highway Coordinator of the District in which the desired section of highway is located.
